

COOL ROOFS project:

- New technology: coating that reduces solar gains on roof surfaces
- Accelerate the integration of the COOL ROOFS technology in the market
- Certification criteria for COOL ROOF products
- Overcome policy and legislative barriers
- Establishment of the COOL ROOFS COUNCIL

iSERV – continuous monitoring and inspection of HVAC systems

iSERV project:

- Develop a tool for automatically inspecting systems
- •Benchmarking with similar systems in the same region or across the EU.
- Automatic detection of inefficiencies in the system
- Involvement of policy makers AND industry
- Testing 1.600 systems across the EU

ZEMEDS – NZE Schools in the Mediterranean Region



ZEMEDS project:

- Develop a model for the refurbishment of schools for the Mediterranean climate
- Direct support to procurement procedures
- Involvement of all parts working in the process
- Under negotiation!



Building skills for craftsmen





- New! BUILD UP SKILLS initiative to train the building workforce
- Continuing education and training of craftsmen and other on-site construction workers and system installers



- A priority of the new EE Plan
 - 2011-2012: support for the development of national roadmaps (21 countries + 9 more in the pipeline)
 - 2012+: support for the implementation of training schemes
